

## **Postal Services**

**Whereas** Canada Post's December 2013 five point plan includes eliminating door to door delivery, drastically increasing postal rates, closing public postal counters and the loss of thousands of decent jobs: and

**Whereas** eliminating door to door delivery and replacing it with Community Mailboxes will have a negative impact on seniors: and

**Whereas** dramatically increasing the cost of first class postage will hurt seniors and their organizations: and

**Whereas** closing public postal counters is unwise and a step towards the further deterioration of a public post office: and

**Whereas** the loss of decent jobs is bad for communities: and

**Whereas** BC Forum has already publicly opposed these changes

**Therefore be it resolved that** the British Columbia Federation of Retired Union Members (BC FORUM) will:

- continue to oppose Canada Post's five point plan
